All abstracts are to be mailed to amumcon2024@gmail.com

- Word limit: 250 [main body of abstract]
- The file type should be PowerPoint
- It should not be more than 3 slides, 1st slide should include a full poster and two slides for further explanation (if required)
- Font Type: Times New Roman
- Font Size: 12 point
- Line spacing: Single
- Left justified
- The presenter will get 3 Minutes to briefly describe his/her study followed by one minute for any questions
- Title of Abstract: Uppercase & Bold, [avoid use of brand/company name]
- Author: Initials followed by surname [Presenting author bold & underlined]. If more than one author, a superscript number is to be inserted at the end of the surname for each author.
- Author address: Should include department, institution, city, state and pin code. If there is more than one author address, a superscript number must be inserted before the address.
- Email of presenting author [Mandatory]
- The main body of the abstract to contain:
 - * Introduction [Study Objectives]
 - * Methods in brief
 - * Results (in summary)
 - * Conclusions [Brief & clear conclusion drawn from results]

Guidelines for Oral Paper Presentation

Number of slides : 10-12 slides

Font Size : Minimum 28 (Times New Roman)

Headings under which a standard oral paper presentation can be prepared:

- Introduction (1 slide)
- Methodology (2 to 3 slides)
- Discussion (2 to 3 slides)
- References (1 slide)
- Aims & Objectives (1 slide)
- Results (3 to 4 slides)
- Conclusion (1 slide)

DATIA ATTRACTIONS



Peetambra Peeth is the famous "**Shakti-Peeth**" of the country. Sh. Golokwasi Swamiji Maharaj established "Bagla Mukhi Devi" and "Dhumawati Mai" at this place. Vankhandeshwar Temple at PeetambraPeeth is one of the Mahabharat-Kaleen temples of Shiva.

Datia Palace, also known as **Bir Singh Palace** or Bir Singh Dev Palace. The speciality of the palace is that it has 7 floors and no member of the royal family lived in the palace. The founder of the Datia State in Bundelkhand - Maharaj Birsingh Deo built many such 52 monuments all around the country.



Sonagiri or Swarnagiri about 76 km from Datia, has scores of Jain temples dating from the 9th century onwards. It is located in the Datia district of Madhya Pradesh, India. This location is popular among devotees and ascetic saints to practice self-discipline, and austerity and to attain Moksha.

Jhansi Fort or Jhansi ka Qila is a fortress situated on a large hilltop. It served as a stronghold of the Chandela Kings in Balwant Nagar from the 11th through the 17th century. It was a primary British settlement in the town and had been constructed by a treaty of the British with the Newalkar Maharaja of Jhansi in 7804.



Sukma Dukma Dam is a British-era dam on the Betwa River in Babina, Jhansi, Uttar Pradesh. The dam was built between 7905 and 7909 as a secondary dam to Parichha Dam. The dam is 800 meters long and serves the drinking and irrigation needs of the Bundelkhand region.
